2nd lopsided hockey win keeps Renegades on top

First place in the Waterloo Region boys high school hockey league is not unfamiliar territory for the Grand River Renegades of Kitchener.

However, the Rens, defending league and playoff champions, have some early-season company in the 13-team league's top spot, including three teams not accustomed to the lofty status of co-leader.

The Renegades chalked up their second straight decisive victory in three days, blasting the Waterloo Vikings 11-1 at the Grand River arena but they share a 2-0 won-lost chart with the Kitchener-Waterloo (KCI) Raiders, the Elmira Lancers and the Glenview Park Panthers of Cambridge.

The Raiders made the six-game schedule's biggest noise when they dumped the Forest Heights Trojans (1-1) of Kitchener 7-4 at McLaren arena.

Glenview scored the deciding goal in a 10-9 struggle with the Preston Panthers (0-2) of Cambridge at McIntosh arena and Elmira had too much firepower in a 9-2 home-ice romp over the St. David Celtics (0-2) of Waterloo.

In other games Thursday, St. Mary's Eagles of Kitchener opened their season with an 8-6 victory over the Cameron Heights Golden Gaels (0-2) of Kitchener and the Southwood Sabres of Cambridge evened their record to 1-1 with a 7-3 verdict over the Eastwood Rebels (0-2) of Kitchener.

In an afternoon that had no shortage of offence — 77 goals were pumped past beleaguered goaltenders — Grand River's Duane Hal-

penny was one of 15 players with a multiple-score performance and one of a trio to notch an afternoon high of four.

Other four-goal snipers were Brent Ashmore in the Eagles' win over Cameron and CHCI's Jason Turner who had four in a losing cause. Mike Kuntz of St. Mary's chipped in three for the Eagles and GRCI's Cam Stauch had two for the Rens.

Chris Main, Dan Williams and Phil Wilkinson had two scores each for Glenview to offset two-goal efforts from Preston's Doug Parker and Jeff Brown.

Steve Clarke and Corey Hallman halved four markers to lead KCI to victory over Forest Heights while Kyle Dietrich and Ryan Bester did the same for Elmira in their decision against St. David. Steve Stockford pumped home a pair in Southwood's win against Eastwood.

League action Tuesday will be: Forest Heights against Glenview at McIntosh, Preston at Grand River, Waterloo at Elmira, Cameron against Southwood at Dickson, KCI against St. Mary's at the Kiwanis arena and Resurrection against St. David at Moses Springer. All are scheduled for 3 p.m. starts.
